✓ Bus

From 4th to 18th June 2008, all of Klagenfurt's bus lines end on the ring roads and surround them largely on separate bus lanes. Seven stops are serviced at minute intervals.

In addition to the Klagenfurt bus lines, there are five shuttle bus lines (see overview plan in the middle section) between the stadium, the main train station, the City Centre fan mile and the UEFA EURO 2008™ fan zones.

The shuttle service is free of charge!

Daily shuttle buses:

Shuttle bus 1 (City Centre fan mile – car parks A1,A2,A8)

Shuttle bus 2 (Exhibition Grounds fan zone/City Centre fan mile – car parks C1,C2)

Shuttle buses on match days:

Shuttle bus 3A (stadium - car parks A1,A2,A8)

Shuttle bus 3B (stadium - car parks A1,A3,A4)

Shuttle bus 4 (Exhibition Grounds fan zone/City Centre fan mile - car park B1)

Shuttle bus 5 (Exhibition Grounds fan zone/City Centre fan mile/train station – stadium)

✓ Train

The centrally located main train station (Hauptbahnhof) in Klagenfurt is easily accessible by train and buses from all directions. Furthermore, ÖBB Austrian Railways offer low priced tickets for UEFA EURO 2008™ guests. From the main train station it only takes you a few minutes on foot to get to the City Centre fan mile as well as to the fan zones and to the stadium. On match days there is also a shuttle bus service (shuttle bus 5) to the stadium.

✓ Tickets for buses and trains

Combined Ticket: A match ticket for the UEFA EURO 2008™ is accepted as a travel ticket by the Klagenfurt bus lines (on the match day + following day until 12 midday)

Carinthia Ticket: Valid from 6th until 19th June 2008 for all public means of transport in Carinthia (bus, train). Price: € 39. Available: train stations, regional buses, bus office Klagenfurt (Heiligengeistplatz).

Host City Ticket: On the match day + following day until 12 midday for all public means of transport in Austria.

✓ Airport

On match days you can get from Klagenfurt Airport by train to the city centre by taking the direct shuttle train from Annabichl train station (5 minute walk) to Klagenfurt's main train station. The Klagenfurt bus lines also regularly connect the airport with Klagenfurt's City Centre fan mile.

✓ Taxi

Taxi rank at the stadium: Kanaltalerstrasse

Taxi ranks in the city centre: Hauptpost (main post office), Stauderplatz square, Theatergasse

✓ Car

Access: From all directions via the A2 Südautobahn motorway to the stadium car parks according to the signposts: via the A2 exit Klagenfurt West; to the car parks for the fan zones, City Centre fan mile: via the A2 exit Klagenfurt Ost. Extensive signposting for road traffic and pedestrians ensures that you will find your way around the city.

Stadium Car Parks

Klagenfurt offers a park & ride system for all ticket holders on the three match days. Showing a valid match ticket allows you to access the car parks. From the car parks you can get directly to the stadium on foot on signposted paths or by shuttle bus.

Public Viewing Car Parks

Traffic in the city centre will be greatly limited during the UEFA EURO 2008™. We recommend you to park your car at the Public Viewing car parks (C1, C2, C3 – see plan in the middle section).

From car parks C1 and C2 you can walk (approx. 30 minute walk) or take the shuttle bus (shuttle 2) to the city centre and to the fan zones, from car park C3 take bus line 50.

✓ On foot

In Klagenfurt the fan zones, the City Centre fan mile, the stadium, etc. are easily accessible on foot. All paths are sufficiently signposted and illuminated at night.

Distances on foot in minutes

From the main train station:

To the stadium: approx. 30 minutes (shuttle 5)

To the fan zones: approx. 5 minutes to the Exhibition Grounds fan zone and approx. 15 minutes to the Neuer Platz fan zone

To the City Centre fan mile: approx. 15 minutes

To Public Viewing at Europapark: approx. 45 minutes (bus line 10)

From the City Centre fan mile:

To the Exhibition Grounds fan zone: approx. 15 minutes

To the stadium: approx. 40 minutes (shuttle 5)

To Public Viewing at Europapark: approx. 45 minutes (bus line 10)
