

RESIDUAL WASTE

WHAT GOES IN?

- Yogurt pots, plastic films and carrier bags
- Pencils and crayons, ballpoint pens
- Music cassettes, slides
- Wire, screws, cables, light bulbs
- Window glass
- Meat scraps, bones, ash
- Crockery (ceramics, glass, porcelain), corks
- Plasters, nappies, toothbrushes
- Plastic toys
- Sweepings
- Dog excrement and cat litter (bagged)
- Light bulbs



ORGANIC WASTE

WHAT GOES IN?

Kitchen waste:

- Vegetable and fruit scraps
- Inedible food
- Flowers and pot plants
- Tea and coffee filters
- Egg shells, food scraps

Garden waste:

- Foliage, flowers, weeds, shrub prunings, hedge trimmings, lawn clippings
- Fruit waste, plant waste, Christmas trees (undecorated, cut up)



WASTE PAPER

WHAT GOES IN?

- Letters, notepaper, writing paper and envelopes
- Books, notebooks
- Computer printouts
- Illustrated catalogues, newspapers, journals, magazines, brochures
- Cardboard and detergent boxes, boxes, crushed
- Paper – clean and uncoated
- Paper packaging, paper bags (e.g. sugar or flour bags, rice boxes)
- Corrugated cardboard, folded flat



LIGHTWEIGHT AND METAL PACKAGING

WHAT GOES IN?

Lightweight packaging ...

- Plastic bottles
PET bottles (beverage bottles, cleaning products, personal care products such as shampoo and shower gel etc.)
- Yoghurt pots and other dairy pots
- Trays for fruit, vegetables and fruit nets
- Plastic foil
- Crisp packets or cans
- Packaging for sliced cheese or deli slices
- Polystyrene packaging in small quantities

and metal packaging:

- Metal and aluminium packaging such as cans and tins

“Tetra Pak”:

- Empty milk and beverage cartons



WASTE GLASS

WHAT GOES IN?

- Glass drink bottles (except deposit bottles)
- Empty glass bottles for cosmetics or food (e.g. cooking oil bottles)
- Empty medicine bottles and perfume bottles
- Pickle and jam jars
- **No crockery**
- **No light bulbs**
- **No plate glass**

YOU CAN DROP OFF:

- Bulky waste
- Plastic packaging
- Plastic
- Metal/scrap metal
- Paper, cardboard packaging
- Wood
- Large and small electrical appliances
- Refrigerators
